Philosophy on Coaching and Fútbol

FTBL Academy's number one goal is to foster the innate ability for children to do what they are taught and encouraged to do every day; to be creative and innovative both individually and collectively. A detailed Player Development Pathway has been developed and will contain three stages; Fundamentals (U8 - U12), Youth Development (U13 - U15), Professional Development (U16 - U18). The stages will focus on attaining specific goals which in turn will ensure the player is properly progressing through the Player Development Pathway. Children will be taught the beautiful game through fun and engaging technical and tactical training sessions that are organized in a manner to ensure success for the individual player and team. The training sessions will focus highly on games and activities that allow the individual player a maximum number of physical touches with the ball. This will encourage the individual to explore creatively and experiment in a manner that is conducive to maximum development potential.

At every stage in the **Player Development Pathway** the individual will be the primary focal point with the team as the secondary focal point. Recently, there has been an enormous push of information regarding tactics and system of play in soccer. This barrage has stifled the individual player development and caused a void for learning, growing and creating. FTBL Academy will focus more on the principles of play rather than the tactics and systems of play. This will ensure a more focused approach is taken to individual player development which in turn will ensure individual and team success.

The collective coaching system of this Academy will be highly encouraged to focus on the aforementioned methods to establish creative and innovative individual technical players and incorporate them into the tactical aspect of the team. Children should be taught all positions on the field, to include goalkeeping, and not just be subjected to play one position. Children should be allowed to experiment and find out what they are good at because if a child chooses to play that position on the field they will give it their best effort. Having a child give 100 percent of their effort 100 percent of the time is one of the greatest compliments any coach can receive because it means you are employing all the correct methods of teaching and the child is enjoying what they are doing.

As coaches it is our responsibility to teach and instill a passion for the beautiful game. In order to accomplish this, we need to teach our players to be aware of all the options available to them. This method will produce good decisions, bad decisions and indifferent decisions but by allowing the player to make mistakes and as a coach, supporting/assisting them through this process without negative punishment, will in turn, allow players to develop an ability to quickly identify the right decision in any situation. When the ability to consistently make the correct choice and properly execute becomes automatic and without reminder or contemplation we have truly succeeded and developed exceptional players. This is the true measurement of our success as coaches and is the most gratifying accomplishment that can be attained.

It is truly about the development of each player both individually and tactically and not about winning as many games and trophies as possible. Teaching players to be self-reliant, humble and exceptional sportsmen will be the greatest asset the child can obtain in life and in soccer. This is done by focusing on the child and not winning. Ultimately the fear of failure will be eliminated and an astonishing level of self-determination and self-esteem will be established that can create elite players and teams for many years to come.

- Be match ready: ensure adequate sleep and proper nutrition before each game.
- Show respect at all times for academy policies, coaches, teammates, opponents, and referees.
- Players are responsible for the behavior of their guests at FTBL Academy activities and events.
- Exhibit good sportsmanship at all times.
- Always support and uphold all FTBL Academy policies.

Youth Academy Parents

Parents and guardians are pivotal in nurturing and contributing to the development of not only their own children but all young athletes at FTBL Academy. Your role is instrumental in instilling values of sportsmanship, self-discipline, creativity, and innovation. As a parent or guardian, your primary role is to support and encourage your child in a positive way, rather than assuming the roles of a coach, referee, or commentator. Your support is essential in helping your player commit to their team and the Academy.

FTBL Academy expects the following from parents:

- Timely Payments and Policy Awareness: Ensure that your player's fees are paid on time and in full, and familiarize yourself with the Academy's refund policy.
- Communication Etiquette: Please wait 24 hours after any game or training session to approach any FTBL Academy staff member, team manager, or volunteer with complaints or concerns.
- Updated Household Information: Keep your contact information, including address, phone numbers, and email addresses, up to date with the Academy.
- Punctuality and Responsibility: If your child relies on you for transportation, ensure timely arrivals for all training sessions and games.
- Safety and Supervision: Be attentive to your child during training sessions and games.

Expectations from FTBL Academy Team Managers:

- Attend all mandatory Team Manager meetings organized by FTBL Academy.
- Participate in all team meetings.
- Ensure that no full-time or part-time club employees take on the role of Team Manager.
- Collaborate with coaches to keep team parents informed about all pertinent information regarding the season, including training, game, and event schedules.

- Welcome and assist in orienting new parents/players who join the team during the season.
- For all games, manage the team's roster, player cards, first aid kit, bench, and canopy.
- Abide by the coaching staff's decision regarding Team Manager presence on the field or sidelines during training and games.
- Collect and manage funds for team activities not covered by the club's fees, when applicable.
- Register teams for events approved by FTBL Academy, following guidance from the coaching staff.
- Pass a background check as a prerequisite for the Team Manager or Assistant Team Manager position.
- Strictly adhere to the club's policy of not altering training sessions or game schedules without proper authorization.
- Uphold and promote all FTBL Academy policies at all times.



Our training is designed to directly translate into improved performance in matches, with activities mirroring real-game scenarios to best prepare our players.

As players grow within the Youth Academy, they will acquire a robust foundation in fundamental skills, a deep understanding of our playing style, and become fully immersed in FTBL Academy's culture. The dedication shown by players aids our Player Development Staff in ensuring appropriate development within their peer group and establishing a clear path towards their future in competitive or elitelevel soccer. Youth Academy players can anticipate significant playing time, with a goal of participating in at least 50% of the matches during the season.

Training at FTBL Academy

Training Sessions at FTBL Academy

FTBL Academy players are expected to show unwavering commitment to their soccer development through regular participation in our training sessions. These sessions are exclusively for players and our dedicated coaching staff. Parents and other spectators are welcome to watch but must remain as observers only, unless a coach explicitly requests their involvement. Players should wear the approved FTBL Academy kit to all training sessions.

Group Training - Emphasizing Individual Skills

At FTBL Academy, we utilize group training to create a high-quality coaching environment focused on individual player development. This method allows players to be grouped by skill level, acknowledging that each player evolves at their own pace. The benefits include enhanced competition, an enriched training environment, and accelerated individual growth.

Benefits of Group Training:

- Tailored, age-appropriate training exercises.
- Focus on individual player development over team performance.
- Addressing specific needs of each player.
- Grouping by skill and age narrows developmental gaps and fosters meaningful competition.
- Flexible training groups ensure optimal development environments.
- Promotes a strong academy culture and team spirit.
- Fosters friendships and broadens social interactions across different age groups.
- Regular evaluations and feedback from our coaching staff.

Training Methodology for Advanced Players

Our approach is integral to our overall philosophy of player development. Training is designed to directly enhance game performance, closely simulating real game situations.

We utilize two primary training methodologies:

Play-Practice-Play Methodology: This player-centric approach allows players to engage in game-like situations extensively. It moves away from traditional drill-based practices to more dynamic, engaging sessions that mirror actual soccer gameplay.

Progressive Coaching Methodology: This method involves game-related activities that gradually become more complex, helping players understand and apply our principles of play in various game scenarios. It starts with basic exercises, progressively adding complexity to thoroughly prepare players for real-game situations.

Training Phases:

- Warm-Up: Prepares players both physically and mentally, using either physical or technical exercises.
- Orientation Stage: Introduces players to specific game scenarios, focusing on understanding and problem-solving.
- Learning Stage: Teaches solutions through experiential learning, emphasizing decision-making skills.
- Implementation Stage: Players apply what they've learned in unrestricted game settings.

Training at FTBL Academy

Trial and Training Players

Trial Players: Those who missed initial tryouts can join training sessions for a period, subject to league and transfer rules. This offers an opportunity to integrate new players seamlessly.

Training Players: In cases where team placement isn't possible, players may be designated as 'Training Players'. They will train with teams and may participate as guest players in events, without being part of the regular team roster.

FTBL Academy is dedicated to nurturing creative, innovative soccer talent, providing an environment where players can express themselves and reach their full potential.

Player Identification

At FTBL Academy, our elite teams are crafted through diverse evaluation methods. We identify players during matches, tryouts, and exclusive training sessions. Evaluations for our elite teams can happen anytime during the year, provided the player isn't already registered with another team in the same league at a different club. All individual elite player evaluation sessions at FTBL Academy are complimentary. This policy is applicable solely to our elite development programs.

Matches

The majority of matches our teams participate in are regulated by official soccer leagues. Consequently, FTBL Academy has limited influence over match schedules and locations. For specific details, please refer to the league's website or consult your FTBL Academy Player Development Coach (PDC). Occasionally, circumstances may necessitate training sessions or matches on non-standard days or times, including Sundays and weekdays. Schedules for games and practices are subject to change due to various factors like bye weeks, field conditions, and weather-related events.

At FTBL Academy, all matches are overseen by our Player Development Coaches. Others, such as Team Managers and parents, are strictly prohibited from coaching players during matches. Generally, at younger and non-elite levels, one registered Volunteer parent Team Manager is permitted alongside the PDC for safety and to maintain a calm, professional sideline. In higher age groups and elite levels, only FTBL Academy Coaching Staff are allowed on the sidelines, and the volunteer parent Team Manager will join the parents' side. Your PDC will provide details about sideline access for Team Managers.


In instances where a PDC is unavailable for a match, the registered Team Manager should be the sole adult on the team sideline, operating as per the PDC's or a FTBL Staff member's guidance. The PDC is responsible for the team's pre-game warm-up. Should they be delayed, the Team Manager, following the PDC's instructions, may conduct the warm-up until a PDC arrives. In older age groups, players should be familiar with their team warm-up routine and may not need a Team Manager-led warm-up.

At FTBL Academy, PDCs may reassign players between teams, leagues, and age groups to optimize player development. All such player movements are initiated and overseen by our Player Development Staff.

Our matches are not the goal in itself. The matches help us to develop our players. It's not about winning, it's about implementing what we learn in our training environment.



Future Plan




At every stage in the Player Development Pathway the individual will be the primary focal point with the team as the secondary focal point. Recently, there has been an enormous push of information regarding tactics and system of play in soccer. This barrage has stifled the individual player development and caused a void for learning, growing and creating. FTBL Academy will focus more on the principles of play rather than the tactics and systems of play. This will ensure a more focused approach is taken to individual player development which in turn will ensure individual and team success.

The philosophy of winning at all cost will not be tolerated in this Academy; it is truly about the development of each player both individually and tactically and not about winning as many games and trophies as possible. Winning should never be the focus of anything we do as coaches; rather a by-product of what and how we teach and coach. Teaching players to be self-reliant, humble and exceptional sportsmen will be the greatest asset the child can obtain in life and in soccer. This is done by focusing on the child and not winning. Ultimately the fear of failure will be eliminated and an astonishing level of self-determination and self-esteem will be established that can create elite players and teams for many years to come.



Annual Cycle



We recognize that there's no possible way for a human to learn all the techniques and tactics of soccer before they complete their youth career at age 18, and that attempting to do so will only result in poorly developed skills and little tactical understanding that can be used at the highest level.

Coaches will learn to appreciate how a team containing multiple players with these abilities will eventually dominate ball possession plus the creation and finishing of goal-scoring opportunities.


















"My generation learnt to play soccer in the street. Our skill levels greatly improved because of the lack of space and the fact that there were few of us meant that we were always involved in the game. The street was our soccer school. Players like Pele, Beckenbauer, Platini, Di Stefano, and myself all started by kicking a football, tin cans, rubber ball, or even rags in the street against guys who would fight to get the 'ball' off of you. You had to rely on your quick thinking and your skill when playing against these guys, because not only are they bigger than you, but space was tight and you were often under great pressure. During those games, I'd use walls, my teammates and even the curb of the pavement. My favorite move was to kick the ball against a wall and control the rebound whilst running at speed, as this split second was often the crucial difference between a great goal and loss of possession.

Youngsters need to develop a close personal relationship with the ball. They need to get to know it and love it as quality is only achieved through many hours of lonely practice. When I played for Ajax juniors, each boy had a football with his name on it. In Spain, at the grassroots level often there is only one ball for the whole team. At Ajax, my ball "Cruyff" was my friend and I had lots of affection for it."

Our conduct, both on and off the field, reflects our academy. We anticipate exemplary behavior from everyone associated with FTBL Academy, including board members, coaches, administrators, volunteers, parents, and players. All are encouraged to maintain a positive and supportive attitude. Competitor clubs, players, parents, and referees are partners in our journey to celebrate the beautiful game.

Alongside our Code of Conduct, our academy policies, philosophies, and expectations are designed to foster an organized and effective environment, enhancing the experience for all involved. Our Player Development Coaches at FTBL Academy continuously assess player progress. To maximize individual player growth, coaches may reassign players among teams, genders, age groups, or leagues. Similarly, teams may be shifted between genders, age groups, or leagues as needed.

FTBL Academy cannot promise that a player will remain with a specific team for a season or year. Likewise, we cannot assure that a coach assigned to a team for a certain season or year will be present at every game and training session. Our focus remains on fostering the innate ability of players to be creative and innovative, in line with our vision and mission.

Fees, Payments, and Refunds

Fees

By registering or accepting a position in one of our teams, you are acknowledging your player's commitment to the team, the Academy, and the associated fees for their participation for a full year or season, as applicable.

Fees at FTBL Academy may vary depending on the program and the level of play or age group of your player. We offer a range of programs, each with its own structure. It's important for parents/guardians to fully understand the program they are enrolling their player in, and we encourage inquiries about any potential costs associated with the chosen program before registration.

Payments

FTBL Academy offers a monthly subscription model to simplify fee payments for our families. This subscription will automatically renew on the first day of each training month, ensuring seamless continuation of your player's training and development.

We understand that schedules can change, and we are committed to accommodating these changes as much as possible. If there are updates to your player's schedule or if you need to cancel a session, we ask that parents communicate these changes directly to the coach within 15 days of the scheduled change or cancellation. This advance notice helps us manage our resources effectively and ensures that we can provide the best possible experience for all players.

Our streamlined subscription model is designed to reduce administrative burdens and provide a more convenient experience for families. It allows for better planning and resource allocation within FTBL Academy, ensuring that each player receives the focused, player-centric training that is central to our philosophy.

We appreciate your cooperation in keeping your subscriptions up to date and communicating any changes in a timely manner. This collaboration is vital in maintaining the high standard of training and development at FTBL Academy.

We strive to provide flexible payment options that accommodate the varied needs of our players and their families. Our goal is to ensure that every player has access to the right level of training and support to thrive in soccer. We appreciate your cooperation in maintaining timely payments and communicating any changes as needed.

FTBL Academy offers various training formats to cater to the diverse needs of our players, each with its unique payment structure.

- Small Group Training: This format focuses on teamwork and group dynamics. Fees for small group training are structured to reflect the collective nature of the sessions, offering an economical option while still delivering high-quality training.
- Semi-Private Training: Tailored for players seeking more personalized attention within a small group context, the semi-private training fees are set to balance the benefits of individualized focus and group interaction.
- Private Training: For players requiring one-on-one coaching, private training sessions are available.
 These sessions are priced to reflect the personalized and intensive nature of the training, offering a bespoke experience for individual development.
- Academy Team Seasonal Payment: Players
 who are part of the FTBL Academy teams will have
 the option to pay for the entire season upfront. This
 payment covers all regular training sessions,
 matches, and other team-related activities for the
 season. This option offers convenience and ensures
 uninterrupted participation throughout the season.

Fees, Payments, and Refunds

Refunds

At FTBL Academy, we understand that unforeseen circumstances may arise, impacting a player's ability to continue with our program. FTBL Academy is dedicated to providing high-quality soccer training for players of various ages, abilities, and backgrounds. We diligently plan each soccer season, securing skilled coaches, arranging field maintenance, ordering uniforms, and organizing activities based on our registered player count. Much of the fees collected are allocated towards these expenses well before the season starts. As such, requests for refunds can compromise the quality and planning of our programs.

No Refunds for Voluntary Withdrawal or Removal: If a player chooses to withdraw or is removed from a team for any reason after accepting a place, they will not be eligible for a refund of any fees paid. This also includes a commitment to fulfill any pending payments for the current season. Previous season unpaid balances must be cleared before registering for new seasons. All financial obligations must be met before any player releases are granted. Accepting a team invitation signifies automatic and irrevocable agreement to these financial commitments.

Exceptions to the No-Refund Policy:

- Season-Ending Injury: Players who suffer a seasonending injury during an FTBL Academy activity may be eligible for a partial refund (excluding a \$25.00 processing fee) for the remaining seasonal year. This refund does not cover uniform costs, payment processing fees, or fees related to league and tournament participation. Official medical documentation is required.
- Relocation: Players relocating more than 50 miles from our training facilities can request a refund or waiver for the remaining fees (excluding a \$25.00 processing fee), calculated from the date of ceasing participation or the date written notice of relocation is provided. Proof of relocation is required.
- Inability to Place a Player: While we strive to place every player on a team, if FTBL Academy is unable to do so, a full refund will be issued. Alternatively, players may be offered the role of a "Training Player," participating in training and guest playing in events, without being rostered for weekly games.
 Terms and conditions for this arrangement will be communicated by the Academy's administration.

Make-Up Sessions and Inclement Weather

Make-Up Sessions

At FTBL Academy, we understand that unforeseen circumstances can sometimes prevent players from attending their scheduled training sessions. To accommodate these instances and ensure our players continue to develop their soccer skills without interruption, we have established a flexible make-up sessions policy. Our policy allows players to attend a make-up session on any day training is offered, providing the flexibility needed to accommodate busy schedules and unexpected conflicts. This approach is in line with our commitment to a player-centric focus, ensuring that every player has the opportunity to grow and express their talent on the pitch.

To utilize a make-up session, we simply ask that parents or guardians send a quick message to the coach, informing them of the missed session and the planned make-up day. This communication is crucial for maintaining the integrity of our training programs and helps us prepare accordingly. There is no time limit for when a make-up session must be completed, offering further flexibility to our players and their families. However, it is the responsibility of the player and their guardians to keep track of missed sessions and to update the coach on their make-up plans. This policy fosters a sense of responsibility and accountability among our players, aligning with our core values of respect, integrity, and trust.

Inclement Weather

FTBL Academy is committed to ensuring the safety and well-being of all its players, coaches, and families. We recognize that weather conditions can be unpredictable, and we strive to make informed decisions regarding training sessions and games. Our approach to inclement weather is as follows:

- Decision-Making Timeline: Decisions regarding field closures will be made by 3 PM daily. However, we acknowledge that weather conditions can change rapidly; therefore, updates might be issued closer to training or game times if necessary.
- Field Control Variability: FTBL Academy utilizes a
 variety of facilities, ranging from rented fields with
 limited control over closures to fields we fully
 manage. This means that one location may be open
 while another may be closed on the same day due
 to differing weather impacts.
- Procedures During Inclement Weather:
 - In cases of severe weather, such as lightning, all players, coaches, and parents are required to immediately seek shelter in their vehicles.
 Further instructions will be provided by FTBL Academy staff.
 - FTBL Academy will communicate any decisions regarding field closures, delays, or re-openings promptly through our preferred notification systems to all parents and players.
- League Game Cancellations: For matches under league jurisdiction, cancellations will be governed by the policies of the respective leagues and the clubs hosting the games. We advise checking the relevant league websites for detailed information on their specific policies.

Player Safety and Health

FTBL Academy is dedicated to providing a secure environment for all players. While we make every reasonable effort to ensure safety, we remind parents not to leave players unattended at any facility. Ensure that a coach or team manager from FTBL Academy is present before leaving your child at any training session or game.

We advocate the "Buddy System" for players when using restrooms during games and training sessions. Parents or designated chaperones are responsible for their players during travel. Stay vigilant about your surroundings.

Aligned with U.S. Soccer's Safe Soccer Framework, FTBL Academy participates in creating a safe environment free from emotional, physical, or sexual abuse. This framework includes comprehensive policies, processes, screening, education, and training for detecting, reporting, and preventing abuse.

Player Health

Waiver, Release of Liability, and Assumption of Risk Agreement

In consideration of participating or allowing my minor child to participate in FTBL Academy practices, games, and events (collectively, the "Activities"), I agree as follows:

The "Released Parties" include FTBL Academy and its officers, directors, employees, contractors, coaches, agents, and representatives.

1. I acknowledge the inherent risks associated with the Activities, including potential exposure to illnesses such as COVID-19. These risks may result in personal injury or death. Participation in Activities is voluntary and undertaken at my own risk.

- I understand that the risks cannot be eliminated without compromising the essential qualities of the Activities. I assume all risks of illness, injury, or death, from any cause, during my or my child's participation.
- I waive, release, and discharge the Released Parties from any claims or liabilities arising from participation in the Activities, including but not limited to those related to COVID-19.
- I agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Released Parties from any claims or liabilities resulting from my or my child's participation, including those arising from their own negligence.
- This agreement applies if the participant is a minor, and I have full authority to agree on behalf of the minor child.
- I confirm having adequate insurance to cover any injury or illness, or I accept the responsibility to bear the costs myself.
- If any part of this agreement is found void or unenforceable, the remainder remains valid. This agreement constitutes the entire understanding related to its subject matter.
